**Seeding Rate: 20-30lb/A**

**50%** Improved Tall Fescue

**38%** Late Heading Orchardgrass

**12%** Barfleo Timothy

*An easy to dry all grass mixture that can be mixed with alfalfa and clovers or seeded alone. The varieties in this mixture are all very leafy and very late heading. Contains premium endo-phyte free tall fescue along with premium late heading orchardgrass and Barfleo timothy. The tall fescue adds more consistent yield and quality along with better persistence.*

## Soil Adaptation:

Adapted to most soil types except for excessively wet soils.  
Wet—timothy and tall fescue will tolerate wetter soils  
Drought—Very good, but timothy will not do well under a drought  
pH range: 6.0 and higher.

## Cutting Management:

Cut leaving a 3-4 inch stubble height. Orchardgrass yields, regrowth and persistence will decrease with short cuttings.

## Stand life:

Long lived with proper cutting management.

## Traffic Tolerance:

Excellent. Tall fescue has superior traffic tolerance.

### Uses:

Dry Hay: Very Good  
Haylage/Balage: Excellent  
Intensive Grazing: Acceptable.  
Palatability of tall fescue is low in summer months. Do not use for high production livestock.  
Add clover if desired.  
Continuous Grazing: Acceptable.  
Palatability of tall fescue is low in summer months. Do not use for high production livestock.  
Add clover if desired.

### Establishment:

Seeding Rate:  
straight: 20-30 lb/acre.  
w/ legume: 3-10lb/acre. (7 most common) use large seed box.  
Depth: 1/8-3/8 inch  
Speed: Slow, but will be very productive in years 2 and higher.  
Nurse Crop: Tall fescue and orchardgrass are shade tolerant and a nurse crop is beneficial in establishment.
