



# Illini 3279Na Soybeans

### 3.2 RM

An early Group III Conventional Soybean variety with SCN (type R) resistance.

**Drainage:** Needs good soil drainage but adapts to most types of soils and conditions. Very drought tolerant.

**Planting:** Plant into firm weed free seedbed. Control weeds prior to planting. You may also spray herbicides and drill in no till-situations. Plant into soils with temperatures of 65 degrees or above; plant to a depth of 1".

**Inoculate with Soybean Inoculant for best results.**
