BMR Forage Sorghum

KF Fiber-Pro 70 FS is a newly developed brachytic dwarf BMR 6 forage sorghum. This hybrid will not get taller than 6-7 feet, which gives it superior standability. The BMR trait indicates reduced lignin, which will increase the NDFD and IVTD. It has large leaves and creates a canopy ideal for suppressing weed pressure and evaporation. It will be in the soft dough stage at approximately 110-115 days. KF Fiber-Pro 70 FS makes excellent tonnage (up to 25 tons) by producing more leaves, thicker stalks and wider leaves while maintaining a reasonable height that will stand. This hybrid needs to be planted in the late spring or early summer to reach full maturity (soft dough stage).

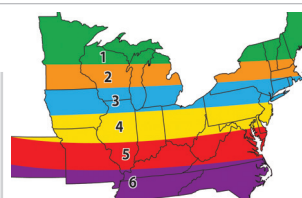
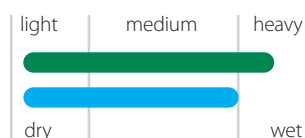
