Superior winter hardiness along with high palatability and quality describe this Certified Organic mix that will perform well on heavier soils. An excellent mix for soils that tend to be on the wetter side, but will also tolerate drought well.

Soil Adaptation:

Adapted to moist to good soils north of the Mason Dixon line.

Likes high fertility.

Wet—timothy, meadow fescue and perennial ryegrass components are all resilient in wet conditions

Drought—Meadow fescue will thrive the most in drought. Clovers will be average, and perennial ryegrass will not do as well.
pH range: 6.0 and higher

Cutting Management:

Cut leaving a 3 to 4 inch stubble height. Wide swath management recommended to quickly harvest the forage

Stand life:

2-3 years. Ryegrass and timothy can last up to 6 years in the right conditions

Traffic Tolerance:

Good. All varieties have adequate traffic tolerance.
